Rules and Regulations for the Administration of the Eastern Star Training Awards for Religious Leadership, State of Oklahoma ESTARL

- Applicant must be a resident of Oklahoma, but not necessarily a son or daughter of a Master Mason or Eastern Star member. Other qualifications being equal, the sons or daughters of Master Masons or Eastern Star member shall be given preference.
- 2. Applicant must be a member of a Christian Church or Jewish faith and have declared his or her intention to devote his or her life to full time religious service in one of the following categories:
 - a. Ministry
 - b. Missionary
 - c. Director of Religious Education
 - d. Director of Church Music
 - e. Youth Director
- 3. Applicant must have completed at least two full years of college and pursued a course designed to qualify him or her for one the professions listed in Paragraph 2.
- 4. Applicant shall write to this committee a personal letter stating his or her aim in life, the reasons and need for this scholarship award and the reason for embarking on a career of religious work.
- The application shall be accompanied by transcripts of all high school and college credits to date, showing the grades made in each subject.
- 6. Letter of Recommendation must be secured by the applicant from:

 (Letter of Recommendation may be included with the application or sent directly to the Chairman)
 - a. Minister
 - b. Professor
 - c. Parent or close relative
 - d. Creditor or lender regarding financial need
- Scholarships shall be granted on a competitive basis and the number shall be governed by the amount of the scholarship fund.
- 8. Applicant must sign an agreement stating that if, after having been awarded a scholarship, he or she does not become actively engaged in said vocation within a period of two years following completion of the required course of study, that the money so awarded shall be considered a loan and shall be paid back to the O.E.S. Grand Chapter in accordance with the terms of the agreement.
- 9. No more than four (4) awards will be granted to an individual.
- All questions must be answered in full.
- 11. The application, agreement, transcripts, letters of recommendation, etc. must be on file with the ESTARL Chairman by June 1, 2018.
